CENSUS FOR BOARD ELECTIONS AT CONSEIL SCOLAIRE CENTRE-NORD

EDMONTON, January 17, 2017 - In anticipation of the upcoming election of school board trustees, the Conseil scolaire Centre-Nord (Conseil) decided to carry out a census of its electors.

An individual can register as an elector, if that individual:

- is 18 years of age older,
- is a Canadian citizen,
- has been a resident of Alberta for 6 consecutive months immediately preceding election day.

In addition, an individual must be able to respond to at least one of the following criteria:

- is a parent of a child or children enrolled (kindergarten to grade 12) in a school or schools operated by Conseil,
- was enrolled as a student in a school operated by a francophone school board (Francophone Regional Authority) and received an Alberta High School Diploma or Certificate from a Francophone Regional Authority,
- is the biological or adoptive parent of an individual who was enrolled as a student in a school operated by a Francophone Regional Authority and received an Alberta High School Diploma or Certificate from a Francophone Regional Authority.

Census forms will be mailed to parents who have a child currently enrolled in a school operated by the Conseil, to our recent graduates (last three years) and their parents. For other eligible individuals, forms are available at the school board office, at all schools operated by the Conseil, and on its website www.centrenord.ab.ca. The census form will also be published in the French weekly, Le Franco, and in selected English newspapers. Only those forms received on or before **February 15, 2017, at 4 p.m.**, will be accounted for in the results of this census.
